Please be kindly informed that COSCO Shipping Lines decided to adjust the rule for Wharfage charges (WHF) at USA ports on trade 106/107 effective from Sep, 2<sup>nd</sup> 2020, as you find it as below.

Rule Context : (Applicable only to cargo destined to Atlantic and Gulf).

(a) The charges for wharfage and handling will apply as established in the applicable FMC port authority tariffs of all U.S. Gulf of Mexico ports and U.S. Atlantic ports (where applicable) being served by Carrier:

at Houston: \$63.06 per container  
at Mobile: \$60.00 per container  
at Miami: \$37.00 per 20' container  
\$75.00 per 40' container  
\$75.00 per 45' container  
at New Orleans: \$68.00 per container

(b) These charges are to be assessed, billed and collected in the U.S.A. unless prior to shipment, the Shipper declares in writing that such charges will be paid at origin,

(c) This rule applies only to wharfage and handling charges, which are specified for the account of the cargo or cargo interests in the port/terminal Tariff on file with the Federal Maritime Commission.
